USE FORMAL VERBS

- √ increase, decrease, discuss, improve, deteriorate, continue, raise
- X go up, go down, talk about, get better, get worse, go on, bring up



USE THE FULL FORM OF VERBS

- √ do not, cannot, will not, did not
- X don't. can't. won't. didn't



USE FORMAL GRAMMAR STRUCTURES

- √ The increasing pollution of the environment is a global concern.
- X The environment is increasingly polluted. This is a global concern.



USE STATEMENTS

- √ There were four main reasons for the decline.
- X What were the reasons for the decline?



USE IMPERSONAL LANGUAGE

- √ There are three main problems.
- X I can think of three main problems.
- √ In the experiment, the water was heated...
- X In the experiment, I heated the water...



BE PRECISE

- √ There are three main reasons for this.
- X There are several things which led to this.



CITE YOUR SOURCES

- √ Russell (2001) states that over 50% of the population are unaware of the problem.
- X Most people are unaware of the problem.



USE TENTATIVE LANGUAGE

- √ This may be caused by the effects of global warming.
- X This is caused by the effects of global warming.
