When taking notes you need to write down the main ideas quickly. Symbols and abbreviations can help.



Almost any word can be shortened to make an abbreviation. The following are some common ways to shorten words.

USE THE BEGINNINGS OF WORDS

- pol politics
- gov government
- subj subject
- info information
- intro introduction

OMIT VOWELS

- prblm problem
- schl school
- bkgd background

ABBREVIATE Specific words

E.g. in a lecture on acid rain, the following could be used:

- AR acid rain
- S sulphur
- N nitrogen
- pol pollution
- facs factories

USE THE BEGINNINGS OF WORDS + FINAL LETTER

- govt government
- gov't government
- interl international
- inter'l international

ABBREVIATE - ING

- ckg checking
- ckng checking
- ck'g checking

USE PERSONAL SYMBOLS/ABBREVIATIONS

Develop a personal list, e.g. from your own language.

- 人 (Chinese character for 'people')
- dgl (German abbreviation for der gleich meaning 'the same' or 'similarly')
